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## ABSTRACT

This research was aimed to found out the improvements of students' speaking skill by using retelling story technique in the tenth grade students of SMK Sangkuriang 1 Cimahi. This research was used pre experimental one-group pretest-posttest design where the researcher only used one class as the experiment class, and this research also used quantitative as the research method. Population of this research was the tenth grade students of AKL major, and total of the population were 108 students. However, the total samples of this research were 30 students in class AKL 2. The instruments of speaking test were pretest and posttest (pretest was given before treatment to know students' competence in speaking and posttest was given after treatment to know students' improvement in speaking). The treatment was conducted in five meetings. The data were analyzed by using SPSS type 23. The result of SPSS showed that the means of pretest was 45.87 and posttest was 62.13. Besides, the statistics resulted of Asymp. Sig. (2-tailed) was 0.000, this means that the value is less than 0.05. From that result, the researcher could conclude that the null hypothesis ( $H_0$ ) was rejected, it means that retelling story technique could improve students' speaking skill.

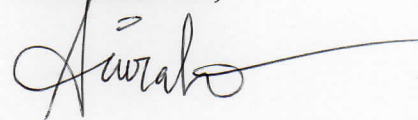

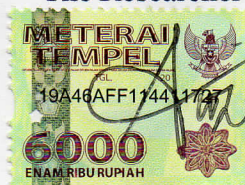
