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ABSTRACT

In writing process students SMA Terpadu Rahmatika face several problem related to find the idea and motivation. Collaborative writing and mind mapping technique was claimed to help teacher to make students improve their skills. This research aimed to figure out whether or not collaborative writing and mind mapping can improve students writing skills and to find out which technique that presents higher score for teaching writing narrative text to the tenth grade of SMA Terpadu Rahmatika. This research applied quasi experimental research. There were two classes, one as experimental class taught by collaborative writing and another class as control class taught by mind mapping technique. The subjects of this research were 60 students. The data were collected from pretest and posttest. The results of this research showed that result of hypothesis u-test was 0.000. So, the null hypothesis was rejected. So, it concluded that teaching writing narrative text using collaborative writing and mind mapping technique can improve students' writing skills especially in writing narrative text. Moreover, to figure out the more suitable technique can be seen from mean of gained score of experimental class was 0.50 and the mean of gained score of control class was 0.17. It mean that the more suitable technique in teaching writing narrative text for the tenth grade of SMA Terpadu Rahmatika is collaborative writing because the gained score of collaborative writing is higher than mind mapping technique.
