

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter the researcher presents the conclusion and suggestion based on the findings of this research.

A. Conclusions

Based on the discussion of the research finding in previous chapter, this research was focused on finding which methods are more effective in teaching speaking . Both of teaching method which are problem based learning and snowball throwing method could improve students' skill in speaking descriptive text at class 7-1 and 7-6 at SMPN 1 CIHAMPELAS in academic year 2019/2020. It was proved by the result of researcher test before and after given treatment with problem based learning and snowball throwing method. The mean score of students' taught by problem based learning in pre-test score which was 46,27 and the students' post-test score which was 62,67. Meanwhile, the means score of students' taught by Snowball Throwing method in pre-test score which was 46,13 and the students' post-test score which was 48,27. Because Pretest H_0 at rejected then a difference between the experimental class method and the control class. And Posttest H_0 not rejected then a difference between the experimental class method and the control class. And the hypothesis there is not difference in the speaking ability of students used problem based learning approach and communicative approach

Based on the result above, the researcher concluded that the used Snowball throwing method in teaching descriptive text was more effective in class because student enjoyed than used problem based method. The results of students' mean score taught by PBL method was bigger than the used of communicative approach

In implementation of communicative approach, there are consist of five times of treatment to improve students' skill speaking descriptive text . Most of students' were difficulties when speaking descriptive text . The researcher decided to use new teaching method in teaching descriptive text. The researcher was used problem based learning and snowball throwing method as teaching method. In this research would focus to found which method can be more effective in learning speaking descriptive text .

B. Suggestions

Based on the result of the research, the researcher would like to give some suggestions.

1. Suggestions for the teachers

- a. Teachers should be more creative in choosing approaches and technique, attractive, and confident during teaching and learning process.
- b. Teachers should encourage, motivate students to get used to speak. They should create different atmosphere, give pay attention in learning process, and make the students feel relax and fun during learning process.
- c. Teachers should give pay more attention to vocabulary and grammar aspect. It is not only for speaking, but also for other fields, such as writing.
