

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter explain about making conclusions and suggestion that related to the conclusion.

A. Conclusions

Based on the research findings in chapter IV, the researcher made the conclusions as follows:

1. The implementation of the Numbered Heads Together technique was appropriate with the lesson plans and learning scenarios that have been made by the researcher, as can be seen from the results of the observation sheet. Although some question did not convey because the time was over. However, students were always follow the lesson from the preliminary activity until finish. Therefore, the use of the Numbered Heads Together technique was useful for the teacher to create a new pleasant learning.
2. The teacher and student gave a positive response toward the implementation of teaching reading comprehension on narrative text using the Numbered Heads Together technique. It can be seen from the result of questionnaire, test, and interview. Students like the use of the Numbered Heads Together (NHT) technique to English reading. It is caused made students more active during learning English reading, students can discuss the question with their group, and made the pleasant learning in the classroom more interesting. The students' scores also increased after implemented the Numbered Heads

Together (NHT) technique in classroom. The teacher also supports the use of the Numbered Heads Together technique because students can help each other while studying.

3. Students got difficulties in learning used the Numbered Heads Together technique in the third stage, namely "Heads-together". Students argued that not all students can join in discussing questions from the teacher, because they did not understand the meaning of the text given by the teacher.

B. Suggestions

After made conclusions, there were some suggestions for a teacher, student, and future researcher as follows:

1. For Teacher

Teachers must be able to manage time correctly because every school has a different time policy, so it must be adjusted to the school. Furthermore, the teacher must know which students are high and low abilities to create a group.

2. For Students

Students are expected to be able to discuss with all group members, so during the learning process students can help each other.

3. For Future Researcher

The results of this research can be used as a reference for further researcher, before conducted the research to enrich the source about the Numbered Heads Together technique.
